Once events are finished, all ATV's will be escorted back to the parking lot in a group. Local law enforcement and fair officials will be patrolling the lot and violators will be dealt with accordingly and not allowed in this or next year's event. (It only takes a few violators and the ATV Rodeo and Pull will be cancelled in the upcoming years. Please help by cooperating with this rule). Safety is a priority at the fair.
4. Only those ATV's currently participating in the event will be running and / or operating. There will be no passengers allowed on ATV's going to and from the parking lot.
5. All participants will sign a liability waiver and must have a parent's signature if under 18 years old.
6. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed prior or during the rodeo. Anyone seeming intoxicated will be disqualified or not allowed to register.

4. Contestant must remain seated on tractor at all times during the pull.

Rules of Conduct by participants, parents and spectators:

1. Any arguing with the track officials by a contestant, parent or guardian will not be allowed and could result in disqualification of the contestant.
2. We demand a display of good sportsmanship in all situations and should that not be the case, the offender will be asked to leave.
3. Please respect that all event officials and judges decisions are FINAL.

Rules:

1. Each contestant MUST have a parent or legal guardian sign the registration form and be present at all times during the pull.
2. The Fauquier County Fair, Inc., board members, sled operators and sponsors will NOT be held responsible for any accidents or injuries and the parent or guardian's signature on the registration form expresses complete understanding of this rule.
3. All pullers will utilize tractors and sled provided.
4. All contestants will be given two chances to get the sled moving from the starting line.
5. The pulling tractor must stay between the lines while pulling. If the tractor crosses one of the side lines, the pull is over and the pull will be measured to where it crossed the side line.
6. Contestant will be disqualified for backing up, jerking the tractor, or stomping on the pedals.
7. If forward momentum of the tractor stops, including foot slipping from pedal, the pull is over.
8. Boys and girls will pull together.
9. Contestant MUST be present when it is their time to pull or be disqualified.
10. Payment of entry fee is required before contestant may participate.
11. In case of a tie, a pull-off will be held.
12. Measurements will be made by event officials and all decisions will be final.
