Contestant packet pick up:

- A director will be available at this time to answer any pageant related questions you may have.
 - Contestants do not have to be present; a family member may pick up.
 - Packet will contain (1) ticket for contestant to enter the fair on the day of the pageant.
 - Must be picked up on
 - Friday July 8th 6-8pm at the Stage
 - Sunday July 10th 4-5pm at the Stage
 - Monday July 11th 1-4pm in the exhibit building
 - Tuesday July 12th 8-11am in the exhibit building
- * If you are unable to have someone pick up packet on one of these days please e-mail missfauquiercofair@gmail.com to see if any additional accommodations can be made available.

Competition:

- **Contestants Baby-Wee (0 months- 3 years)** will compete in “summer wear”; summer wear is anything “Off the rack” this should not be “pageant wear”. **No Swim Suits.**
- **Contestants in Tiny-Little Miss (4 years- 7 years)** will compete in “Sundays best”; this should not be “pageant wear” these should be “off the rack” dresses. Think tea party, Easter type dresses. Dresses may be long or short. (Natural looking, age appropriate make up is permitted, i.e.. lip-gloss)
- All contestants should arrive pageant ready. There will be no prep room available for contestants. Please stop at the building to use the restroom prior to coming to the pavilion.
- Contestants should line up behind stage 15 minutes prior to scheduled competition time. There will be numbers along the back of the stage that will align with the contestant number given in pageant packet.
- ONE parent must remain with contestant at all times. (Except Little Miss)
- ONE parent is permitted on stage with contestants 3 and under. Points may be deducted for any contestant age 4 and over requiring a parent on stage.
- At the conclusion of crowning please pick up contestants on the left side of the stage.

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PAGEANT RULES AND REGULATIONS

****All rules are aligned with Miss Virginia Association of Fair****

Contestant must be single, never married, without children, and never having been pregnant.

Contestant must be between the ages listed **on the date of the pageant.**

Contestant must possess strong moral character. She will not be allowed to compete if she has been convicted of a crime or has criminal charges pending against her (not including minor traffic violations). She will not be allowed to compete if she has engaged in any activity, which is characterized as dishonest, immoral, indecent, or in bad taste. This also includes any improper action on social media, in print, or via any electronic form of communication. Contestants must also be in good standing with their school.

Contestant must be a Virginia resident, and (Contestant or Parent) must be a resident, student, or employee in Fauquier County. Contestants CAN compete in the Pageant more than once.

Due to the change in Rules & Regulations, age categories, the cancellation of the 2019 & 2020 fair, etc. all age groups are open to all contestants. (Including winners of the 2018 pageants) please contact pageant directors if you have any questions.

Contestant and all accompanying pageant guests will conduct themselves in a proper, professional manner at ALL times. Any display of uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification.

There will be a ZERO tolerance policy for BULLYING.

Contestant must remain on stage until ALL awards are presented. Any removal off stage by parents will result in disqualification of contestant for any future pageants.

The decisions of the judges and directors are final.

The Fauquier County Fair Pageant committee, reserves the right to deny applications and/or disqualify contestants with just cause. Contestants will be notified via Mail if application is denied.
